



## DRESS CODE POLICY

Justice Electronic Training Services, Inc. DBA/J.E.T.S, has a basic dress code policy, which must be adhered to in order to ensure a safe training and manufacturing environment.

Whether attending classes at J.E.T.S or working within our manufacturing environment, students, sub-contractors or employees are required to dress as if they are working within a production environment. Students, sub-contractors, and employees are expected to exercise good business sense and reasonable judgment in determining what is the appropriate dress standard for a given business situation/activity relative to his or her work. Men and Women with shoulder length or longer hair must tie it back in a ponytail. All students, sub-contractors, and employees must wear enclosed shoes and no thin heels higher than 1-inch. Casual dress slacks, Capri's, clean jeans, non-collared shirts and comfortable shoes are acceptable. Holes, rips or tears in any clothing not acceptable. Open-toed shoes, shorts, tank tops, belly shirts, low cut tops, low cut slacks/jeans, tops with thin straps, T-Shirts with offensive images or statements and cut off sweatshirts are not permitted.
